Criminal Law – Deadly Weapons on School Property – Nonpublic Schools (No Weapons on Nonpublic School Property Act) OPPOSE

This legislation crosses Constitutional lines by negating the right of private individuals and privately owned institutions to make management and policy decisions regarding the exercise of protected rights on their own private property.

HB 302 sets a dangerous precedent and clearly demonstrates the government's intent to incrementally restrict and prohibit the possession of firearms in Maryland.
