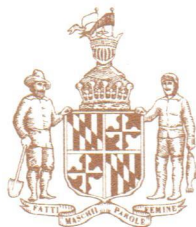

Dear Committee Members:

I request your support for SB 248. This bill simply adds attempted carjacking and attempted armed carjacking to the list of crimes for which a juvenile can be tried as an adult. The code already includes attempts to commit other crimes as well as the crimes of carjacking and armed carjacking. It makes no sense to exclude attempted carjacking and attempted armed carjacking from the list of crimes for which a juvenile can be tried as an adult.
