Then in 2015 my boyfriend at the time and I got in a fight and he kicked me in the back down the stairs in front of our house. My tailbone fractured. My hip is so out of alignment and now I have horrible back and hip pain. I knew I couldn't live in this pain and do what I needed to as a mother. But I also knew taking opiates was not an option for me either. So I started googling natural medicines to relieve pain and came across kratom. I was skeptical at first.
