

My name is Adam Warner (33 yrs.), and I am from Pittsburgh, PA. I am an architectural illustrator (3D Renderings, Animations, Virtual Reality and etc.) and photographer at one of the largest architecture firms in Pennsylvania. I have been taking kratom for about 4 years, and I honestly feel that it has saved my life. I have been battling chronic arthritic pain throughout most of my body (knees, hips, hands, back) along with a severely curved spine since my mid 20's. From this constant battle, came fairly severe depression and anxiety. Things like grocery shopping to cutting grass became such a daunting task that it was taking a huge toll on me both physically and mentally...basically, I was unable to be on my feet for more 20-30 minutes at a time without sever, crippling pain that would often carry over into my evenings, causing lots of issues sleeping. Eventually I was being prescribed tramadol to manage my pain, but I quickly realized that this was not a long term solution. Being on that for extended period of time was ruining my life (taking properly as prescribed) and coming off of it seemed impossible until I found Kratom.

Kratom gave me my life back. I was able to do all of the normal daily things that were becoming huge hurdles. The reality of being so young, but feeling so old had finally subsided, and I was able to get back to a normal life of someone in their late 20's/early 30's. Without Kratom, I would have not have been able to do that, and without it, I dont know how I would continue having a positive quality of life. Im now able to walk several miles each day to and from work, maintain a house, and simply find the joy in life again. The pain is still there and likely always will be, but Kratom has been the only long term solution that have been able to maintain a consistent dose of and wasn't destroying other parts of my life.

My wife and I just built a house last year, I have been a positive contributor to the architecture community for going on 13 years, and we are hoping to try having our first child very soon. Having to deal with those obstacles without kratom or being on previous pain medications would have most certainly not made these things in my life possible, and I genuinely feel I would be in a very dark place without it.

I hope this testimonial helps support your/our effort, and I will continue to always be looking for other ways to contribute. I do need to ask though, unless you absolutely need to use my full name, please only use my first name. It kills me, but unfortunately, I need to be cautious with my career due to the assumptions of people that are uneducated.
