My name is Felicia, I have been a consumer of Kratom for the past 8 months. I was addicted to opiates, opiates that weren't prescribed by a doctor. I wanted more than anything to get clean and I was willing to do whatever I had to do, but I was so depressed. I went to a program 3x a week and therapy 3x a week. I went to meetings but nothing could take that depressive state I was in away. Eventually, I relapsed. I stayed clean about 5 months that time. The third time, I tried with Kratom. I've been hearing about it but I felt it was pointless. I really thought I'd never get clean because I'd been there 2x before. I remember crying my eyes out and praying to God asking him, begging him to please, please help me. I was tired of of the life I was living, I even contemplated suicide. A voice in my head told me to give Kratom a real try. I remember being a part of a Facebook group with about 20k people in it. More than half of them were in the same boat as I. I saw them living happy productive lives because of Kratom. With help of the group, I learned how to use it and where to purchase safe, tested quality Kratom. That was 8 months ago, and I can for the 1st time in a long time, maybe even my life say...I am clean and I am happy. Genuinely happy! Since then, I've purchased a car and even got my own place. I'm doing things I wouldn't have dreamed of being able to when I was in active addiction. I'm a much better mom to my son.
