Testimony for HB 388

As a Designated Immigration Officer for the Frederick County Sheriff's Office, I respectfully offer written and verbal testimony in opposition to the HB 388. I would like to point out that any time a Detainee is served with an Immigration Detainer they are also served with an Immigration Warrant. The Immigration warrant is an Administrative Warrant that isn't signed by a Judge. I would like to point out that most criminal warrant aren't signed by a judicial Judge and can be signed by a clerk. Some examples would be Circuit Court and District Court Failure to Appear and Circuit Body Attachments (Child Support & Contempt of Court) Also, a County Commissioner can issue an Arrest Warrant that can be served without a Judge signing it.

I also would like to point out that an ICE Detainer is no different than a hold from another county that can hold a person up to 48 on a week day and longer if served on a weekend. Also, anyone served with a Fugitive Warrant can be held on that hold for up to 30 days.
