HB 34 Campaign Finance - Contributions, Expenditures, or Donations by Foreign-

Influenced Corporations or Foreign Principals (SUPPORT)

House Bill 34 prohibits a foreign-influenced corporation or foreign principal from making a contribution or independent expenditure to a campaign finance entity. It further prohibits foreign-influenced corporations or foreign principals from making electioneering communications for a campaign. The legislation also requires corporations that do make contributions, independent expenditures, or electioneering communications to, within 7 days, file a statement with the State Board of Elections certifying that, after due inquiry, the corporation was not a foreign-influenced corporation on the date of the contribution, independent expenditure, or electioneering communication.

We know from the 2016 presidential election that foreign entities sought to influence the outcome in favor of one candidate and at the expense of another. The Office of Attorney General strongly believes that safeguarding our elections from foreign influence is a matter of utmost urgency and that this measure should garner bipartisan, unanimous, support. For all of the foregoing reasons, we urge the Committee to favorably report HB 34.
