Testimony for HB1005  
Ways and Means Committee

Good afternoon Madame Chairwoman, Mr. Vice-Chairman, and distinguished members of the committee. I am Delegate C.T. Wilson and it's a privilege to be here to present **House Bill 1005 entitled Education-Health and Safety of Students-Notification of Problematic Sexual Behavior.**

**Bill Overview:**

Requiring public schools and nonpublic schools that receive State funds to notify parents or guardians of certain students involved in an incident of problematic sexual behavior by the close of business on the day of the incident; and requiring a county board to ensure that certain schools have a certain policy in place regarding a certain notification.

**Bill Outline:**

1. Requiring a notification system in school to notify parents or guardians of students involved in problematic sexual behavior within a specific time period.
2. Requires a county board of education to have a specific policy in place for notification in schools
3. Specific definition of pertaining terms

**Conclusion:** This bill will create and enforce a notification system by schools to parents and guardians of children involved in incidents of problematic sexual behavior in schools.
