This bill would allow the county to borrow money and sell notes in anticipation of the receipt of Bay Restoration Funds. MBIA supports this measure. The Bay Restoration Fund is an important economic and environmental influx to the Chesapeake Bay area. However, the funding itself can be prevented by numerous approvals and procedures for its use. This bill would allow for a more smooth and consistent source of funding and prevent projects from slowing down due to lack of funds.
