AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1091
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with “requiring” in line 15 down through “value;” in line 17; and in line 18, after “contracts;” insert “requiring a procurement officer to give certain notice to the Secretary of the Board of Public Works or the Secretary’s designee before awarding a certain emergency procurement contract with a certain value; authorizing the Board to request a hold on a certain emergency procurement contract; requiring a procurement officer to get approval from the Board before awarding a certain emergency procurement contract under certain circumstances; authorizing the Board to waive a certain requirement under certain circumstances;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, strike lines 26 and 27 in their entirety; and in lines 28, 30, and 32, strike “(V)”, “(4)”, and “(VI)”, respectively, and substitute “(IV)”, “(5)”, and “(V)”, respectively.

On page 4, in lines 1 and 30, in each instance, strike “(5)” and substitute “(6)”; and in line 3, after “(4)” insert “(I) THIS PARAGRAPH APPLIES ONLY TO AN EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT CONTRACT WITH A VALUE OF \$1,000,000 OR MORE.”

(II) THE PROCUREMENT OFFICER SHALL GIVE NOTICE TO THE SECRETARY OF THE BOARD OR THE SECRETARY’S DESIGNEE BEFORE AWARDING AN EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT CONTRACT.

(Over)

(III) 1. THE BOARD MAY REQUEST A HOLD ON AN EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT CONTRACT.

2. IF THE BOARD REQUESTS A HOLD ON AN EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT CONTRACT, THE PROCUREMENT OFFICER MAY NOT AWARD THE CONTRACT WITHOUT OBTAINING APPROVAL FROM THE BOARD.

(IV) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBPARAGRAPH (III) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, IF \$1,000,000 OR MORE WILL BE PAID UNDER THE PROPOSED EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT CONTRACT BEFORE THE CONTRACTOR BEGINS TO PERFORM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CONTRACT, UNLESS THE BOARD WAIVES THE REQUIREMENT FOR APPROVAL, THE PROCUREMENT OFFICER SHALL OBTAIN BOARD APPROVAL BEFORE AWARDING THE EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT CONTRACT.

On page 5, in lines 12, 16, 20, and 24, strike “(6)”, “(7)”, “(8)”, and “(9)”, respectively, and substitute “(7)”, “(8)”, “(9)”, and “(10)”, respectively; in line 21, strike “A REQUEST” and substitute “WHETHER”; in line 22, strike “REQUIRED” and substitute “PROVIDED FOR”; and in line 23, strike “(3)(IV)” and substitute “(4)”.
