Good afternoon Chairman Guzzone, Vice Chairman Rosapepe, and distinguished members of the committee. It is my pleasure to testify today in **support** of **Senate Bill 591 – Bureau of Revenue Estimates – Tax Incidence Study - Scope.**

Senate Bill 591, expands the scope of an existing tax incidence study that the Bureau of Revenue Estimates (BRE) must submit to the Governor and General Assembly by including toll charges imposed by the State.
