Re: Support of HB 682 - Renewable Energy Portfolio Standard - Thermal Biomass Systems

On behalf of our member families, I submit this written testimony in support with amendment of HB 682, legislation that authorizes thermal biomass systems, for purposes of the State's Renewable Energy Portfolio Standard (RPS), to use food waste, qualifying biomass, or animal manure as a source of fuel, regardless of the relative mix of those fuel sources. Other eligibility requirements related to thermal biomass systems and their fuel components are unchanged. Maryland Farm Bureau supports the clarifying amendments being offered by the Maryland Forests Association to include Silvicultural products and natural wood waste.

MDFB Policy: We support energy generation from all agricultural residues and biproducts to be considered value-added production on a farm.

We support initiatives to generate heat & electricity from timber resources.
