The flu season is upon us. Which type

when they took that shot, by far the

greatest number of the claims, 2/3 of

them are for neurological damage or even

death allegedly triggered by the flu

shot. We pick up the story back in 1976

00:54

when the threat posed by the swine flu

00:57

virus seemed very real indeed. This virus

was the cause of a pandemic in 1918 and

01:04

1919 that resulted in over half a

million deaths in the United States as

01:10

well as 20 million deaths around the

01:12

World, plus. The US government's publicity

01:17

machine was cranked into action to urge

01:19

all America to protect itself against

01:21

the swine flu menace. Influenza is

01:23

serious business.

01:24

During major flu epidemics, millions of

01:27

people are sick and thousands die. Well,

01:30

this year you can get protection. The

01:32

vaccines are safe, easy to take, and they

01:35

can protect you against flu, so roll up

01:38

your sleeve,

01:39

protect yourself. One of those who did

01:43

roll up her sleeve was Judy Roberts. She

01:45

was perfectly healthy, an active woman

01:47

when in November of 1976 she took her

01:50

shot. Two weeks later she says she began

to feel a numbness starting up her legs.

"I joked about it at that time, I said

01:58

I'll be numb to the knees by Friday is

it if this keeps up. By the following

week I was totally paralyzed."

So completely paralyzed in fact that

02:08

they had to operate on her to enable her

02:10

to breathe, and for six months Judy

02.12

Roberts was a quadriplegic. The diagnosis...

a neurological disorder called

Guillain-Barre syndrome, GBS for short.

This neurological disease is little

02:22

understood, they affect people in

02:24

different ways. As you can see in these

02:27

home movies taken by a friend, Judy

02:29

Roberts' paralysis confined her mostly to

a wheelchair for over a year but this

02:34

disease can even kill. Indeed there are

300 claims now pending from the families

02:39

of GBS victims who died allegedly as a

02:42

result of the swine flu shot. In other

GBS victims the crippling effects

02:47

diminish and all but disappear, but for

02:50

Judy Roberts, progress back to good

02:52

health has been painful and partial. "Now

02:55

I noticed that your smile, Judy, is a

02:58

little bit constricted." "Yes, is it

different from what it used to be, a very

03:03

Different. I have a greatly decreased

mobility in my lips and I can't drink

through a straw on the right-hand side. I

can't walk birthday candles

I don't whistle anymore, for which my

husband is grateful. "It may be a little

difficult for you to answer this

Question, but have you recovered as much

as you are going to recover?" "Yes, this is

It." "So you will now have a legacy of

braces on your legs for the rest of your

Life?" "Yes, the weakness in my hands will

stay and the leg braces will stay.

So Judy Roberts and her husband have

03:40

filed a claim against the US government.

03:42

They're asking 12 million dollars, though

03:44

they don't expect to get nearly that

03:45

much. "Judy, why did you take the flu shot?"

"I've never taken any other flu shots, but

03:51

I felt like this was going to be a major

03:54

Epidemic, and the only way to prevent a

03:58

major epidemic of a really deadly

variety of flu was for everybody to be

04:03

Immunized." Why did this so-called deadly

04:06

variety of flu, where did it first hit?

04:08

Back in 1976 it began right here at Fort

04:11

Dix in New Jersey in January of that

year when a number of recruits began to

complain of respiratory ailments,

04:17

something

04:17

like the common cold. An army doctor here

04:20

sent samples of their throat cultures to

04:22

the New Jersey Public Health lab to find

04:24

out just what kind of bug was going

04:26

around here. One of those samples was

from a private, David Lewis, who had left

04:30

his sickbed to go on a forced march.

04:32

Private Lewis had collapsed on that

March and his sergeant had revived him 04:36

by mouth-to-mouth resuscitation, but the 04:38

sergeant showed no signs of illness. A 04:40

few days later, private Louis died. "If 04:44

this disease is so potentially fatal

04:47 that it's going to kill a young healthy

04:49

man, a middle-aged schoolteacher didn't 04:51

have a prayer." The New Jersey lab 04:53

identified most of those soldiers' throat 04:55

cultures as the normal kind of flu virus 04:57

going around back here, but they could 04:59

not make out what kind of virus was in 05:01

the culture from the dead soldier and 05:03

from four others who were sick so they 05:06

sent those cultures to the federal Center 05:08

for Disease Control in Atlanta, Georgia 05:09

for further study. A few days later they 05:12

got the verdict: swine flu, but that 05:15

much-publicized outbreak of swine flu at 05:17

Fort Dix involved only private Lewis who 05:20

died and those four other soldiers who 05:22

recovered completely without the swine 05:24

flu shot. "If I had known at that time 05:28

that the boy had been in a sick bed got 05:31

up, went out on a forced march and then 05:34

collapsed and died I would never have

taken a shot." The rationale for our 05:39

recommendation was not on the basis of
