Written Testimony in SUPPORT of SB 338

Chairman and members of the Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee, I am here to introduce and voice my support for Senate Bill 338 – *Local Government – Animal Control Facilities – Adoption Fee Waiver for Veterans (Pets for Vets Act of 2020)*.

Senate Bill 338 would require an animal control facility operated by a county or municipality to waive the adoption fee for a dog or cat for a veteran. It also authorizes an animal control facility to limit the number of adoption fee waivers granted to an individual to one dog and one cat within a 6-month period.
