Senator Pinsky:

I am writing on behalf of Brewers Hill Neighbors (BHN) to support Senate Bill 426, the 46th Legislative District's annual liquor bill. Two provisions on Senate Bill 426 impact the Brewers Hill neighborhood.

First, is the creation of a Class D license for a Bark Social. Although not the original concept brought to BHN, we have executed a Memorandum of Understanding with the developer and are supportive of the new license.

Second, is the creation of a Class B license for DiPasquale's. BNH has not had significant conversation with the owner, we are supportive in concept with the assurance that a Memorandum of Understanding will be executed prior to the issuance of that license.

Thank you for the Committee's consideration and Brewers Hill Neighbors urges a favorable report.
