## Senator Pinsky:

I am writing on behalf of Brewers Hill Neighbors (BHN) to support Senate Bill 426, the 46<sup>th</sup> Legislative District's annual liquor bill. Two provisions on Senate Bill 426 impact the Brewers Hill neighborhood.

First, is the creation of a Class D license for a Bark Social. Although not the original concept brought to BHN, we have executed a Memorandum of Understanding with the developer and are supportive of the new license.

Second, is the creation of a Class B license for DiPasquale's. BNH has not had significant conversation with the owner, we are supportive in concept with the assurance that a Memorandum of Understanding will be executed prior to the issuance of that license.

Thank you for the Committee's consideration and Brewers Hill Neighbors urges a favorable report.
