SB 141, *State Board of Public Accountancy – Education Requirements – Obsolete References* proposes to replace outdated references in Maryland’s statute referring to the State Board of Public Accountancy to ensure accuracy.

Two of the accrediting bodies listed in statute Section 2-303(c) as acceptable by the board have changed their names. The American Assembly of Collegiate Schools of Business has become the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business, and the Association of Collegiate Business Schools and Programs has become the Accreditation Council for Business Schools and Programs.

SB 141 will provide accuracy within the statute so as to ensure those seeking licensure are aware of the proper accrediting entities. **The Department of Labor supports this legislation and respectfully asks the Committee for a favorable report.**
