Favorable w/ Amendment: HB 399 - SHA - Required Notices for Contracts of Sale - Zones of Dewatering

Dear, Chair Barve and Committee Members:

The NAIOP Maryland Chapters representing more than 700 companies involved in all aspects of commercial, industrial, and mixed-use real estate support HB 399 with an amendment to exempt non-residential property from the required contract disclosure.

Identifying environmental conditions and potential hazards like the presence of a zone of dewatering influence is included in the phase I environmental assessment prospective buyers complete prior to finalizing purchase of non-residential property.

For this reason, NAIOP requests that page 5 line 1 be amended to read:

C) A CONTRACT FOR THE SALE OF <u>RESIDENTIAL</u> REAL PROPERTY SHALL INCLUDE, IN CONSPICUOUS, BOLD, AND UNDERSCORED TYPE, THE FOLLWING BUYER NOTICE IN THE CONTRACT:

For these reasons, NAIOP respectfully requests your favorable w/ amendment report on House Bill 399.
