Favorable w/ Amendment: HB 76 Water Pollution Control – Intervention in Civil Actions – Rights and Authority

Dear, Chair Barve and Committee Members:

The NAIOP Maryland Chapters representing more than 700 companies involved in all aspects of commercial, industrial, and mixed-use real estate support with amendment HB 76 which would broaden the right of a person to intervene in state court actions to enforce state water quality regulations and permits.

NAIOP recommends amendments to clarify:

- 1) the bill does not provide rights broader than allowed in federal cases, and;
- 2) the bill does not extend the broader right to intervene to administrative cases which may be appealed to state court.

Amendment No. 1:

On page 1, line 19, strike “MEETS THE THRESHOLD STANDING REQUIREMENTS” and substitute “COULD INTERVENE IN A SIMILAR ACTION”

Amendment No. 2:

On page 1, line 21, strike “BRINGS” and insert “INITIATES.”

With these amendments NAIOP would respectfully request your favorable w / amendment report on HB 76.
