Currently, many people among the renter class are prevented from equal access to information about elections and candidates through one of the most common forms of outreach: door knocking. Because building owners/landlords set the rules for a shared domicile, they can prevent candidates, and worse, GOTV volunteers, from educating residents about upcoming elections.

If this prevention isn't outlawed, it declares that people of certain financial status should have control and authority of those of a different financial status, and that is not democratic. Worse, it's classist and upholds a caste system in Maryland.

The practice of preventing access to campaign/election volunteers and organizers needs to be prohibited, which is why we support HB0515 and hope you will find it favorable.
