Thank you for your interest in the Maryland Department of the Environment's (MDE) Lead Registration Compliance and Accreditation (LRCA) database. This project is of great interest to many of us involved in lead poisoning prevention.

MDE is continuing to work with a contractor to develop the new database system which is on schedule to go live by October 2021. The project team has completed the Accreditation module framework which is the first of four system modules. We are currently working on program increment 5 (of 8), which focuses on accreditation screen customization, enforcement design and integration with 3rd party applications. A public interface will be part of the system once it is completed later this year. Enclosed is a Sept. 2020 letter updating Chair Barve on the progress of this very important project.
