The League of Women Voters (LWV) supports legislation that promotes the control of climate change as well as encourages the use of renewable resources. Legislative mandates like purchasing zero-emissions buses to aid in the transition to an all zero-emissions bus fleet are a prime example as to how Maryland can promote good environmental policies in the transportation sector.

HB 334 incorporates the important aspect of evaluation of this new program into the bill. Maryland should be making decisions based on technological improvements in the transportation system with measurements. Changes may be made using new technologies in buses and the state should take advantage of these for good environmental stewardship so good decisions may be made based on facts.
