- ON THE NATURE OF whether global warming is an issue that requires government intervention: 1
- WHEREAS according to NASA, it is the scientific consensus that "that 97 percent or more of actively publishing 2
- climate scientists agree: Climate-warming trends over the past century are extremely likely due to human 3
- activities" and "most of the leading scientific organizations worldwide have issued public statements endorsing 4
- this position."[1][2][3][4][5][6] 5

- WHEREAS according to the American Association for the Advancement of Science, the American Chemical 6
- Society, the American Geophysical Union, the American Medical Association, the American Meteorological 7
- Society, the American Physical Society, and the Geological Society of America: "[o]bservations throughout the 8
- world make it clear that climate change is occurring, and rigorous scientific research demonstrates that the 9
- greenhouse gases emitted by human activities are the primary driver."[7][8][9][10][11][12][13][14] 10
- WHEREAS according to the U.S. National Academy of Sciences: "Climate change is real. . . . The evidence 11
- comes from direct measurements of rising surface air temperatures and subsurface ocean temperatures and from 12
- phenomena such as increases in average global sea levels, retreating glaciers, and changes to many physical and 13
  - biological systems" and "most of the warming in recent decades can be attributed to human activities." [14][15]
- WHEREAS according to the U.S. Global Change Research Program: "Earth's climate is now changing faster 15
- than at any point in the history of modern civilization, primarily as a result of human activities." [16][17] 16
- WHEREAS according to the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change: "Warming of the climate system is 17
- unequivocal, and since the 1950s, many of the observed changes are unprecedented over decades to millennia. 18
- The atmosphere and ocean have warmed, the amounts of snow and ice have diminished, and sea level has risen. 19
- ... Human influence on the climate system is clear, and recent anthropogenic emissions of greenhouse gases are 20
- the highest in history." [18][19][20] 21
- WHEREAS 200+ worldwide scientific organizations claim climate change has been caused by humans. [21][22] 22
- WHEREAS "[t]he current warming trend is of particular significance because most of it is extremely likely 23
- (greater than 95% probability) to be the result of human activity since the mid-10<sup>th</sup> century and proceeding at a 24
- rate that is unprecedented over decades to millennia."[23][24][25][26][27][28] 25
- WHEREAS "[t]he heat-trapping nature of carbon dioxide and other gases was demonstrated in the mid-19th 26
- century" and "[t] here is no question that increased levels of greenhouse gases must cause Earth to warm in 27
- response."[29][30][31][32][33][34][35][36][37] 28
- WHEREAS "paleoclimate evidence reveals that current warming is occurring roughly ten times faster than the 29
- average rate of ice-age-recovery warming" and "carbon dioxide from human activity is increasing more than 250 30
- times faster than it did from natural sources after the ice age." [38][39] 31
- WHEREAS the overwhelming majority of academia recognizes human-caused global warming has resulted in 32
- global temperature rise, warming oceans, shrinking ice sheets, glacial retreat, decreased snow cover, sea level 33
  - rise, declining arctic sea ice, extreme events (such as hurricanes and wildfires), and ocean acidification. [40][41][42][43][44][45][46][47][48][49][50][51][52][53][54][55][56][57][58][59][60][61][62][63][64][65]
- THEREFORE climate change is a human-caused issue which requires government intervention to resolve. 36
