"The problem of **distracted driving** has become increasingly prevalent during the past decade in Maryland and across the United States due in large part to the explosion in use of handheld communication devices, such as cell phones and other electronic devices... over 53,000 distracted driving crashes occur on Maryland roads each year." ### **Distracted Driver Laws:**

- Transportation § 21-1124 Use of Handheld Telephones
- Transportation § 21–1124.1 Reading, Writing, or Sending
- Text Messages Transportation §
- 21-1124.1,2,3
- "Jake's Law" Crash resulting in death or serious injury guilty is a misdemeanor on a conviction, up to 1 yr imprisonment, \$5,000 fine

## **High Visibility Enforcement:**

- A "spotter" officer visually identifies driver DD statute violations
- "Spotter" officer radios ahead to another officer providing driver vehicle identification
  - DD HVE is a Maryland SHSP Program Area, providing grants to 47 police departments for enforcement

## **Objective Enforcement:**

- Camera-based "spotter" augments HVE operations
- Camera-based "spotter" removes subjectivity and potential observing bias from violation detection
- Camera-based "spotter" will provide calibrated and traceable performance data & address privacy and equity concerns
