Thank you for the opportunity to present Senate Bill 795 – Oversight Committee on Quality Care in Nursing Homes and Assisted Living Facilities – Membership and Cochairs.

The Oversight Committee on Quality Care in Nursing Homes and Assisted Living Facilities was created by the General Assembly in 2000. The Committee is charged with evaluating progress in improving the quality of nursing home and assisted-living facility care statewide.

Senate Bill 795 alters the membership of the Oversight Committee. Specifically, Senate Bill 795 adds in one representative of Leading Age Maryland. In addition, Senate Bill 795 creates two cochairs elected from the membership. 80% of the committee positions are required to be filled before co-chairs can be elected.
