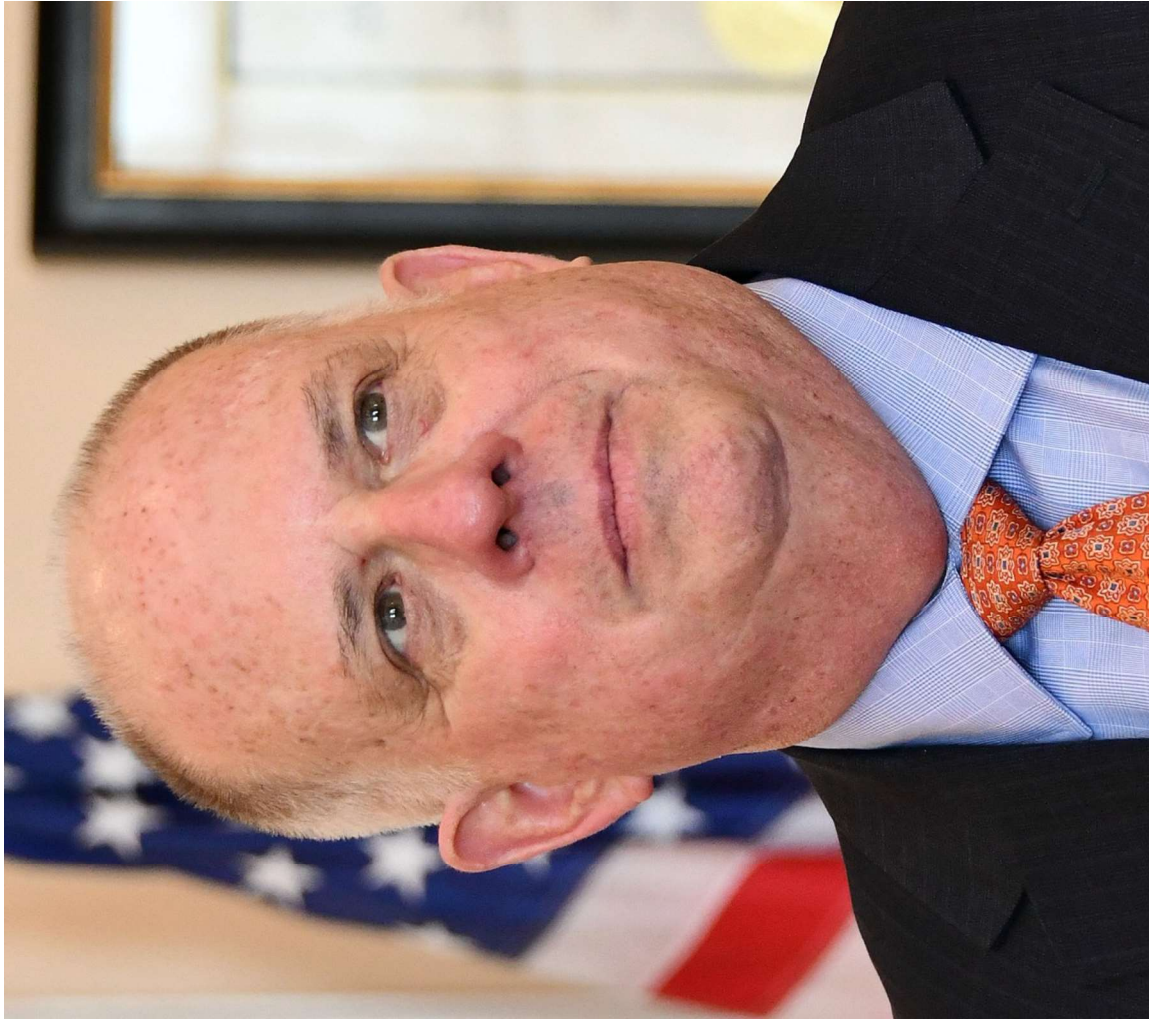

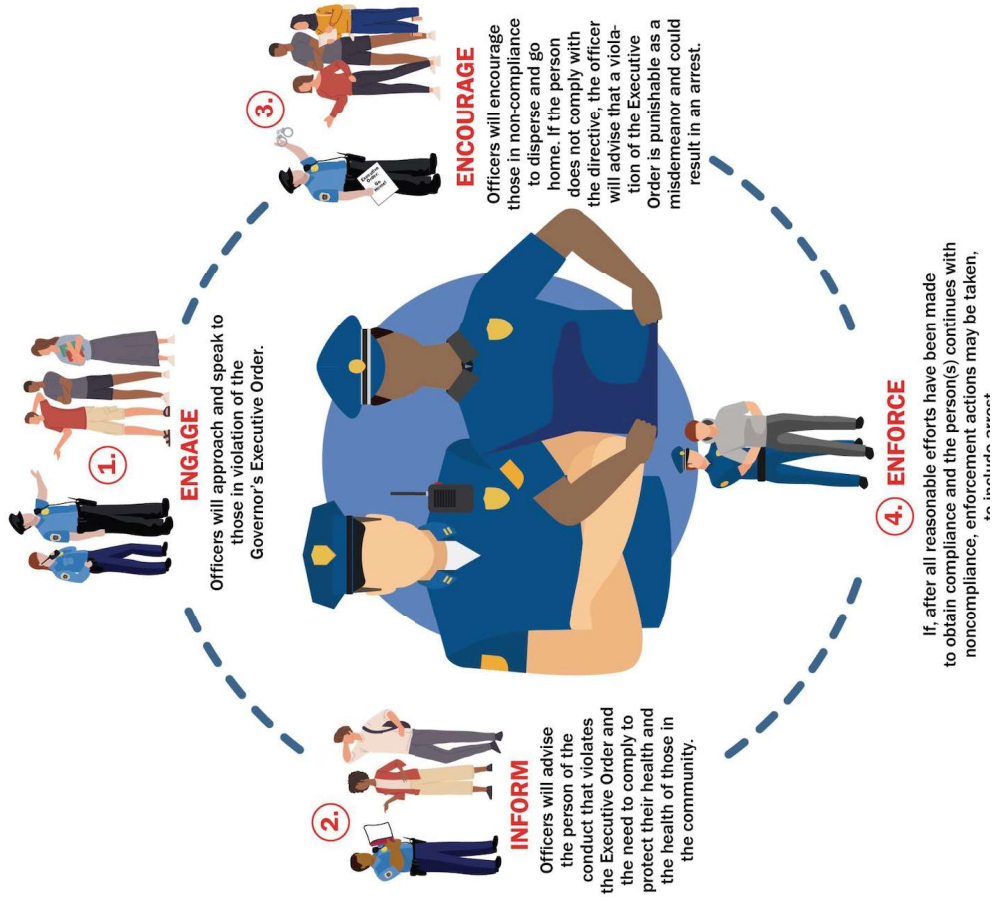

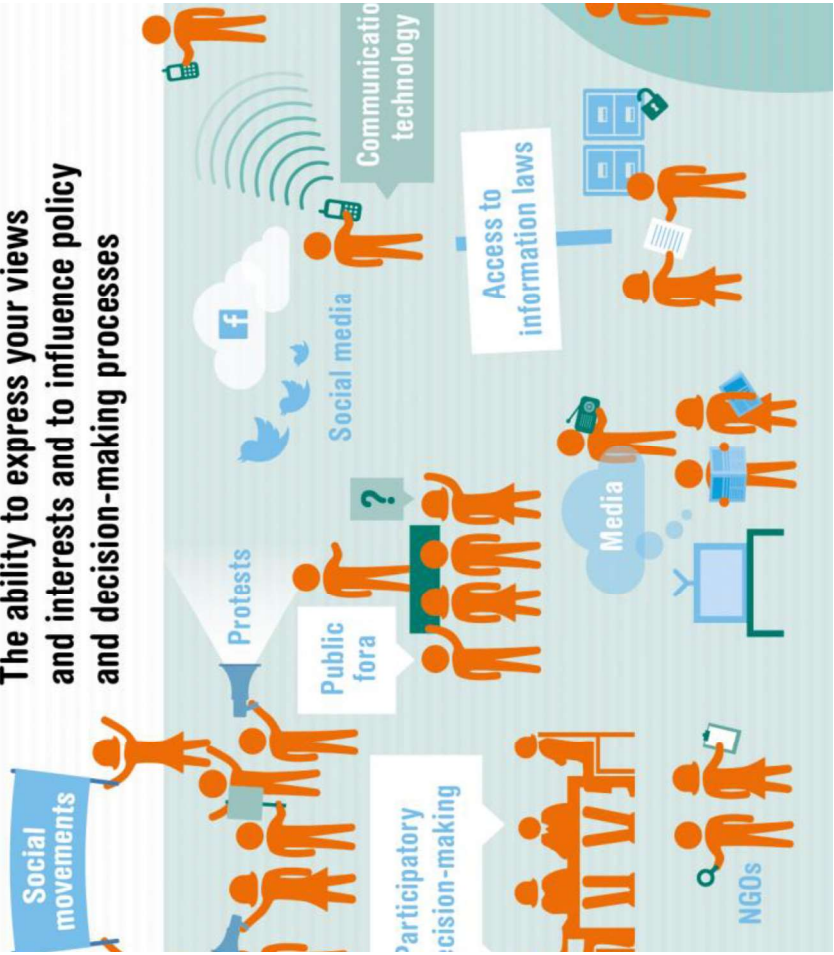

Art. II, sec. 24 – Executive Orders

- Maryland Constitution contemplates the Legislature – either the House or the Senate – is to vote on any Executive Order expanding powers or adding law within 10 days of the start of the General Session and if overturned in 50 days makes the EO void
- Title 14 of the Public Safety Article also contemplates Legislative nullification – but witness and public testimony should be essential as part of our Democratic process

Definition of *dictator*

- a** : a person granted absolute emergency power
especially, history : one appointed by the senate (see [SENATE](#) sense 1a) of ancient Rome
 - b** : one holding complete autocratic control : a person with unlimited governmental power
 - c** : one ruling in an absolute (see [ABSOLUTE](#) sense 2) and often oppressive way
// fascist dictators
- 2** : one who says or reads something for a person to transcribe or for a machine to record : one that dictates (see [DICTATE](#) entry 1 sense 1)
