HB1040 UNFAVORABLE

This bill lowers the age a pharmacist can give a shot to a child from 9 yrs of age (for flu only) and would allow a child <u>THREE</u> YEARS OF AGE to receive any recommended vaccine on the CDC immunization schedule. It increases the possibility that multiple vaccines will be given without PRIOR discussion with a child's physician and there are no studies on synergistic reactions with multiple vaccines given. Also, no prescription is needed and it does not say anything about parental consent. I OPPOSE this bill.
