Dear Madam Chair Pendergrass,

I am submitting this letter seeking your support for House Bill 0586 (Senate Bill 0303).

House Bill 0586 (SB 0303) is a reintroduction to HB0716, heard by your committee in 2020. In 2020 the Senate EHEA committee and full Senate voted unanimously in favor of the Senate version of the bill. This year, House Bill 0586 is scheduled for a hearing in your committee on March 16th, 2021. I believe the Tuskegee group is meriting of special recognition for their significant contributions made to our country.
