

TESTIMONY IN SUPPORT OF  
HB 849 Public Health - Medical Records - Fees

My name is Kristin Voto, and I am a SOAR specialist with the St. Marys County Health Department. I currently help serve those who are homeless, or at risk for becoming homeless and have a mental health diagnosis, obtain SSI/SSDI.

I appreciate the opportunity to provide this testimony in support of House Bill 849.

HB 849 will eliminate fees for medical records for people applying for public benefits such as Social Security Disability.

This bill is critical in my efforts to assist seriously mentally ill people who are homeless or at risk of homelessness apply for public benefits. Fees for medical records are needed to prove disability, but very often the applicant has no funds to pay for these records, and my nonprofit is not in a position to cover the cost.

HB 849 would ensure that low income Marylanders can access the records they need to secure vital public benefits. For this reason, I support HB 849 and urge a favorable report.
