## Maryland General Assembly Special Session Congressional Redistricting Hearing December 6th, 2021 HB0001

Greetings to Delegates Barnes, Delegate Peña-Melynk, and the rest of the Rules & Executive Nominations Committee.

I am a resident of **District 21**, a member of Showing Up for Racial Justice Annapolis & Anne Arundel County (<u>SURJ3A</u>), and a member of the Anne Arundel County Branch of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (<u>NAACP</u>). I am a nurse and a mother of two small children.

I am testifying in regards to congressional redistricting HB0001. I would like the <u>finalized map to include a minority-majority district representing Anne Arundel County</u>, as this would be reflective of the increasing minority population in our county. In 2000, the percentage of white census respondents not Hispanic or Latino was <u>79.8%</u>, in 2010 <u>72.4%</u>, and in 2020 it was down to <u>66.7%</u>. That means minorities now make up a full one third of Anne Arundel County's population. Specifically, I am asking that the final proposed LRAC map keep the <u>minority-majority district 4 that includes parts of AA County</u>.

The recent National conversation has brought to light the racial disparities in this country. We have made a lot of progress, but minorities are still widely underrepresented in state and national politics. Blacks are 14.2% of the population but only make up 10% of state legislators, 13% in the US house of representatives, and 3% in the US Senate. Latinos are 18.7% of the population but just 5.3% of state lawmakers, 9% in the House, and 6% in the Senate. Asian Americans & Pacific Islanders are 6% of the population but are only 2% of state legislators, 3% in the House, and 2% in the Senate (pbs.org & pewresearch.org).

Let's continue to make progress and ensure that minorities have a voice and the power to elect those who represent them and their interests. That's why I am asking you to continue a minority-majority district in AA County. Thank you for your time, service, and consideration.
