TESTIMONY IN SUPPORT OF HB 0120, Public Information Act - Personnel Records -  
Investigations of Law Enforcement Officers (Anton's Law)

Chair Clippinger and members of the House Judiciary Committee, my name is Ayla Hurley, I live in Columbia, Maryland, and I am writing to support Anton's Law, HB 0120.

Anton's Law would prevent the continuation of injustice throughout law enforcement departments in Maryland, and allow Maryland to join the majority of states that do not classify complaints against officers as protected personnel files. 90% of complaints against officers made by the public are not sustained, which damages Marylanders' trust in those officers.

Transparency of investigative procedures is necessary to prevent repeated cases of flagrant officer misconduct, sometimes criminal misconduct, only for them to be acquitted long after the investigation has been determined unsustainable. This helps no one but the unsuitable officers, and harms members of the community, primarily people of color. After the global civil outcries throughout 2020, this legislation can no longer wait. It must be enacted now if trust in Maryland law enforcement is to be rebuilt.

I urge you to support HB 0120 and help ensure that Maryland's law enforcement is being held to the highest standards of conduct.
