WRITTEN TESTIMONY OF SCOTT G. DAVIS IN OPPOSITION TO HB 175

I appreciate the opportunity to present my testimony in opposition to HB 175 to the members of this committee this afternoon.

A background check for the purchase of ammunition is not permitted by federal law. Even if it could be implemented by federal law, it would take a large addition of staff to take care of reviewing all of the background checks just for the purposes of purchasing ammunition. The staff is not in place let alone the cost to take care of this additional service.

In addition, the handgun qualification license is not to be used to purchased ammunition as clearly stated in FSA 2013.

I do not feel the need to further describe the obvious problems with this bill. It is has not crafted by someone with knowledge of firearms or firearms laws.

I request an unfavorable report.
