I Oppose House Bill 336

My name is Ingrid Collazo and I am in favor of the Johns Hopkins Police task force, both as a Health system employee and neighborhood resident. I strongly urge the committee to issue an unfavorable report on HB 336.

As a 14 year resident in the East Baltimore area, I have experienced several incidents where I have appealed to Johns Hopkins security and more often than not they have not shown up. I do not fault them but rather I realize that such things as security escorts (on foot or automotive) are not a high priority on their list as some of the other tasks they have.

It is my belief that a Johns Hopkins Police task force joined with Johns Hopkins security will make a stronger team and not stretch the security department thin, causing them to be over-worked and under-staffed. I believe that there is strength in numbers and this collaboration will make our security team stronger and well recognized within the community. This recognition will serve well as a deterrent to local campus crimes such as assault, harassment etc.
