My name is Dan Kiselik, please accept this email as my personal expression of opposition to MD House Bill HB336, which would eliminate the proposed JHPD.

My wife and I have been residents of Butchers Hill since 2016, when we relocated from suburban NJ. For full disclosure, my wife is a physician and professor at JH medical school.

We are both active, supportive members of the community. I have served on the Butchers Hill Association board since 2017 and on the crime prevention committee since 2016. As a member of both of these bodies, I have had the opportunity to have several candid conversations with representatives of JH regarding the formation of a sworn police force.

Assuming strong independent oversight and accountability is in place, it is my personal opinion that a professional sworn police force employed by JH is an opportunity to advance the state-of-the-art in constitutional policing, provide for the safety of the entire JH community in a more direct and efficient manner and relieve the Baltimore City Police Department from the responsibility of patrolling the various campuses, allowing them to concentrate more time in the city's neighborhoods.
