HB0773 Testimony

GPS devices on firearms would violate the privacy of gun owners. It would invite others, including law enforcement and criminals who have the will and means, to surreptitiously monitor the activity and location of guns and their owners without the permission of the owners. Gun owners, particularly those who legally carry concealed in public, would never truly be carrying concealed which would expose the carrier to unnecessary risk.

I urge an unfavorable report for this bill.
