On behalf of the County Commissioners for Charles County, it is our sincere pleasure to support passage of HB 739/ SB 916.

HB 739/SB 916 establishes a workgroup comprised of representatives from the Senate, House of Delegates, Board of Charles County Commissioners, Charles County Board of Education, Interagency Commission on School Construction, and Maryland Stadium Authority, to address the operational viability of public-private partnerships for Charles County public school construction.

As one the fastest growing Maryland counties, Charles County is being met with many challenges as it relates to properly planning and funding school construction. We believe that an innovative approach is needed to address aging and overcrowded facilities.
