SB337 – Motor Fuel Tax Rates - Consumer Price Index Adjustment - Repeal
Budget and Taxation Committee

Position: Favorable

Background: Automatic motor fuel tax rate increases based on the consumer price index would be repealed.

Comments: The Maryland Retailers Association (MRA) supports the proposal to repeal automatic rate increases for taxes on motor fuel based on the consumer price index (CPI).

The rising cost of goods and services due to inflation caused by the COVID-19 pandemic is having a major impact on households and businesses across the country. Increased prices for goods are related to a variety of factors including the price of raw materials, labor costs at every level of production, and shipping costs.
