Testimony in Support of HB 917 Business Regulation – Home Improvement Commission – Award Limits

Testimony of Delegate Cathi Forbes Hearing February 25, 2022 at 1:00 pm Economic Matters

What this bill does

This bill would increase the amount a homeowner can recover from the Maryland Home Improvement Commission (MHIC) Guaranty Fund from \$20,000 to \$30,000.

Background on the Guaranty Fund

The Maryland Home Improvement Commission administers a Guaranty Fund which exists to reimburse homeowners for the actual loss caused by a licensed contractor who performs a home improvement job in an unworkmanlike, incorrect, or incomplete manner, or who abandons a home improvement job. The Guaranty Fund is funded from part of the licensing fees charged to contractors when they are initially licensed, and each time they renew their license.

In 2000, the amount a homeowner could recover increased from \$10,000 to \$15,000.

In 2008 the amount a homeowner could recover increased from \$15,000 to \$20,000.

Who benefits from this bill

Homeowners who can show actual loss from poor work performed will be closer to being made whole.

Why you should vote for this bill

With the costs of an average bathroom renovation estimated to be between \$12,000-\$30,000 and a kitchen renovation between \$15,000-\$50,000 this bill will add protection for homeowners who choose MHIC licensed contractors.
