RE: **SUPPORT** – House Bill 164 – *Institutions of Higher Education – Pregnant Students – Policy*

The Maryland State Medical Society (MedChi), the largest physician organization in Maryland, **supports** House Bill 164.

House Bill 164 seeks to address the issues that students who are pregnant, have recently given birth, or are non-birth parents face in attempting to advance their education, while addressing the demands associated with pregnancy and early parenthood demands. Academic success is a key factor in enabling students to become productive, self-sufficient individuals who can advance professionally and personally. The added challenges of pregnancy and the initial months after delivery can negatively impact a student, despite a desire and commitment to complete their education and advance their professional development. Passage of House Bill 164 will help ensure that institutions of higher education have policies that support the success and advancement of their students who experience a pregnancy or birth of a child.
