Bill: SB 4 - Cybersecurity Scholarship Program - Alterations and Maryland

Cybersecurity Loan Assistance Repayment Program – Establishment

**Position:** Support

#### **Reason for Position:**

The Maryland Municipal League supports Senate Bill 4, which would expand the Cybersecurity Scholarship Program and create a Cybersecurity Loan Assistance Repayment Program.

Cybersecurity is a field that is ever-increasing in importance. Local governments can often be the target of a cyber attack that results in disruption of services and breach of privacy to the residents. SB 4 expands the list of employers for which students can work in order to fulfill a scholarship or loan repayment requirement. Adding municipal governments to the list not only gives the student real life experience in a local government setting but also allows municipal governments to fulfill cybersecurity needs now and prepare for the future.
