Senate Bill 340 Queen Anne's County – Alcoholic Beverages – License Applications

Dear Chairman and Members of the Committee:

Senate Bill 340 is a local bill that would authorize the Board of Licenses Commissioners to exempt up to four (4) licenses held by corporations and limited liability companies from ownership requirements. It would also prohibit the board from granting an exemption for licensed premises located within the Kent Narrows Commercial Management and Waterfront Improvement District.

Senate Bill 340 is supported by the Queen Anne's County Commissions, the Board of License Commissioner and the Queen Anne's County Delegation.

I request a favorable vote on Senate Bill 242.
