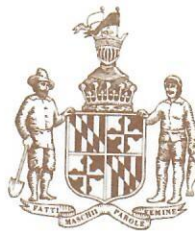

SUPPORT SB648

Frederick County – Alcoholic Beverages Act of 2022

Dear Chair Pinsky, Vice Chair Kagan, and distinguished members of the Senate Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee,

SB648 is a Frederick County Delegation omnibus bill that provides technical corrections to Frederick County's liquor licensing laws.

In particular, **SB648** includes provisions to eliminate duplicative language for:

1. Alcohol awareness training,
2. Crowd control training,
3. Repeal petition support requirements, and
4. Fire Companies, Beer and Wine tastings, Barbershops, Salons, Cinema/Theater, and religious organizations.

SB648 also alters the license renewal time frames, and the dates that the Liquor Licensing Board may issue licenses.

In addition, I offer a Sponsor Amendment to modify the residency requirements per the Office of Attorney General guidance.

I ask that you vote favorably on **SB648** to ensure clarity and consistency in Frederick County's Liquor Licensing laws.
