

**House Bill 927** – Housing and Community Development - Affordable Housing - Listing and Disposal of Excess Real Property

Maryland REALTORS® supports efforts to increase the supply of affordable housing options in Maryland through legislation like HB 927.

Maryland currently faces a shortage of over 82,000 housing units. The availability of land for development is a key factor in whether additional housing options can be constructed at all, much less whether they can be constructed at costs affordable to low- and moderate-income residents. Many of Maryland's most populous areas are now either fully or mostly built-out. In those areas, developable land will be in high demand or be found only through redevelopment, both of which result in housing options that are more expensive.

Several states and larges cities have been able to produce affordable housing in very high-cost areas though the disposal of surplus property. By offering properties to developers by direct donation, land leases, community land trusts or land grants, it is possible to decrease the costs of new dwellings by as much as 35%.
