Municipal Incorporation – County Commissioners or Count Council – Required Consideration of Referendum Request

The Caroline County Commissioners **SUPPORT** HB 620, Caroline County – State's Attorney and Sheriff - Salaries. This legislation increases the State's Attorney of Caroline County's salary to 85% of the Judge of the District Court and increases the Sheriff's salary to 85% of the State's Attorney's salary.

Currently, the State's Attorney receives 80% of the District Court Judges salary, and the Sheriff receives 80% of the State's Attorney's salary. The Caroline County Commissioners brought this request forward to the Caroline County Delegation requesting State sponsorship to increase the salaries of the State's Attorney of Caroline County and the Sheriff of Caroline County.

In closing, the Caroline County Commissioners support HB620 as the Caroline County Commissioners requested this legislation. With this, we respectfully request a favorable report on House Bill 620.
