A RESOLUTION of the Baltimore County Council supporting the Maryland General Assembly's favorable consideration of legislation House Bill 500, introduced in this year's General Assembly Session to prohibit the Maryland Department of Natural Resources (DNR) from dredging buried oyster shells on Man-O-War Shoals or including such dredging as part of a fishery management plan.

WHEREAS, the Man-O-War Shoal is located off of the shores of Southeast Baltimore
County and is the last large oyster reef in the Upper Chesapeake Bay; and

WHEREAS, the 450 plus acre reef contains approximately 100 million bushels of buried oyster shell at its core, which was built up over millennia of oysters continuing use the shoal as a foundation to attach after spawning; and

WHEREAS, from 1960 until 2006, as part of its oyster reef replenishment project, DNR dredged nearly 200 million bushels of buried oyster shell from the Upper Chesapeake Bay and barged it into the southern Bay area where salinity is higher and supports better reproduction and growth of oysters; and

WHEREAS, since the early 2000's, the oyster population in the Chesapeake Bay has languished at 1% of historic levels, the suitable oyster habitat has decreased, and a the number of harvesters has dwindled; and

WHEREAS, in 2004, DNR began establishing sanctuary areas where the harvest of wild
