

## Assisted Living Manager Legislation by State

20 States require Assisted Living Managers to be licensed or certified by the State or a Medical Board:

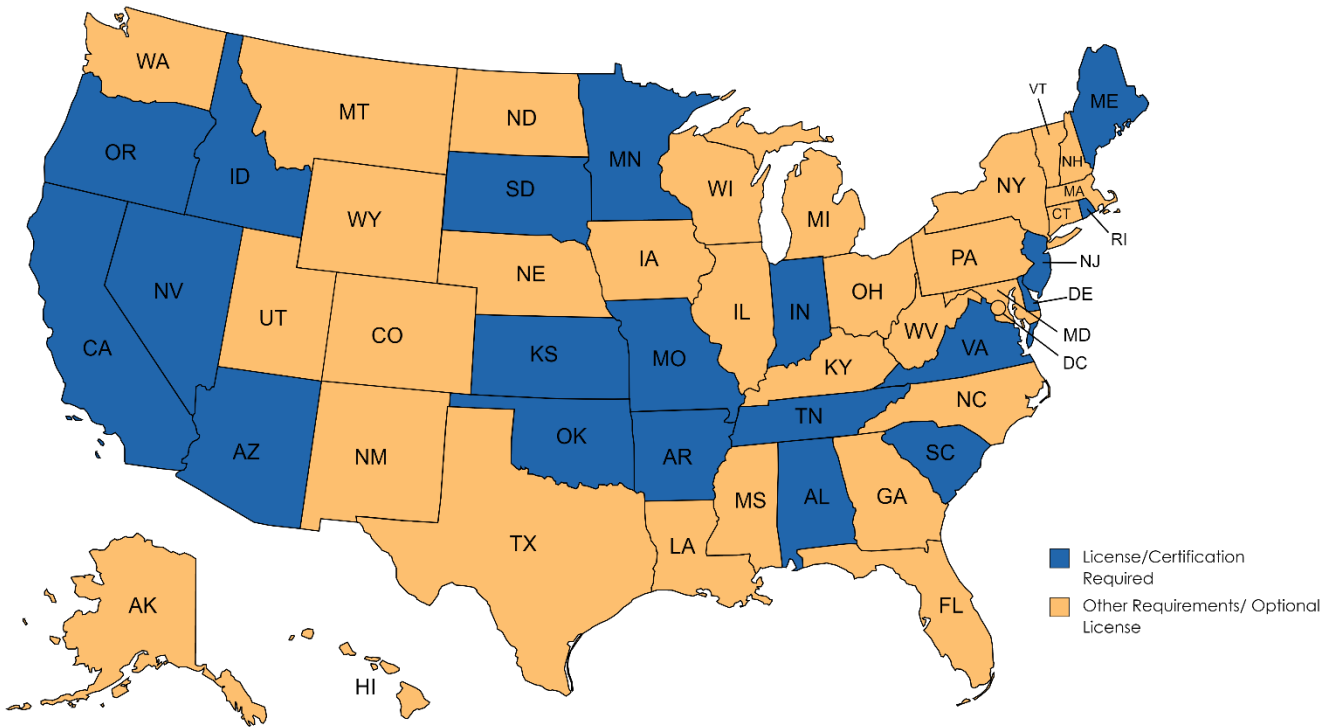
