Dear General Assembly,

I strongly oppose the disgusting, innocent life murdering HB 1171. Abortion advocates have a long history of using euphemisms in an attempt to disguise the horrific nature of the act that they support and promote – namely, the killing of innocent, preborn, human beings. Since the Supreme Court's decision in Roe v.
