Senate Bill 682 – Maryland Community Health System strongly supports Senate Bill 682 – Maryland Medical Assistance Program - Gender-Affirming Treatment (Trans Health Equity Act of 2022) Senate Finance Committee February 22, 2022

The Maryland Affiliate of the American College of Nurse-Midwives strongly supports Senate Bill 682 – Maryland Medical Assistance Program - Gender-Affirming Treatment (Trans Health Equity Act of 2022). The bill would modernize Maryland Medicaid's coverage of gender-affirming treatment to reflect current best practices.

Maryland Medicaid currently excludes many gender-affirming services from coverage because the services are considered "cosmetic." There is a growing recognition among experts that these service denials "reflect a long history of labeling medical care for transgender people as unnecessary, unproven, and unworthy of payment[.]"<sup>i</sup> Senate Bill 682 recognizes that many services sometimes considered "cosmetic" are medically necessary for transgender patients. In addition to addressing symptoms of gender dysphoria, treatments to align outward appearance with a patient's gender identity can decrease the risk of experiencing discrimination and violence.<sup>ii</sup>

By modernizing our state's Medicaid program, we will ensure that more patients can access all medically necessary gender-affirming care. We as for a favorable report.
