I'm against the bill HB 1171 for the following reasons:

- 1. To protect the young and unexperienced minors who are not capable to comprehend the complex of adults' tricks, especially the sick-minded individuals. Minors don't understand the consequences of having sex the way adults do. If these adults are not fairly penalized/disciplined, they will continue to harm the minors, not only physically but mentally. This will take away the chance for the minors to contribute to the society in a natural way. - 3. Taxpayers have no obligation for paying these kinds of services. I don't need to write too long for this. It's common sense that my 3rd grade child can understand. We pay for our own choice benefit/choice (good or bad.) The only time we share the cost as a community is when it serves common good.
