I am a resident of District 40 and live in Baltimore City, Maryland. I strongly oppose HB 1171 as its passage and addition to our State's Declaration of Rights would be a blemish on our state much as slavery was in previous times, and for much the same reason. Just as the slave was considered a "non-human", so too do abortion proponents consider the unborn child a "non-human". However, if one simply "follows the science", specifically biology and genetics, one would realize that at the moment of conception, a new human individual is created with a genetic make-up different from his or her parents. Once there is a heartbeat and brainwaves, there is no denying that there is a life and, genetically, a human life. How Maryland's first African-American female Speaker can propose a constitutional amendment to make this a "right" is beyond comprehension!

Maryland currently has among the most permissive abortion laws in the nation. The last thing we need is a constitutional amendment to enshrine the killing of unborn babies as a right, as something good. Therefore, I urge the members of the General Assembly to vote no on this horrendous bill.
